Inlet Dance Theatre is a professional performing and touring contemporary dance company based in Cleveland. In addition to performing, Inlet engages individuals, public and private schools, colleges and universities, and other educational and cultural institutions through year-round, community-centered programming. Inlet also serves as a mentoring program for pre-professional dance theatre artists and is hired to perform for special events through Inlet Event Services.





Inlet was formed with the belief that dance viewing, training and performing experiences can be used successfully as tools to bring about personal growth and development *using dance to further people.* The company intentionally engages students of various ages, races, backgrounds and skill sets to not only learn about dance, but to instill character-building lessons of teamwork, trust, respect, self-discipline, social interaction and self-confidence. - This exciting new chapter brings with it opportunities for expansion and continued growth!






- Approximately 40% of Inlet's revenue comes from tuition and fees; we rely on donations and grants for the remainder of our revenue.
